- instructor has chosen to teach online
- student has chosen to learn online

## Remote Course

- adaption of a F-2-F course using remote solutions (rapid and temporary)
- individual support as needed
- students may not be ready for remote learning
- environment of wide-spread and significant disruption

## Synchronous

(gather and interact in real time)

#### **Advantages:**

- Immediate, personal, responsive
- Community

#### **Challenges:**

- Scheduling
- Technical

## Asynchronous

(advance preparation of materials; access at time of their choosing)

#### **Advantages:**

- Temporal flexibility
- Accessible
- Increased cognitive engagement

#### **Challenges:**

- Lack of social interaction
- Increased potential for misunderstanding



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
